CLOSEOUT OF A CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Why would a Contractor, Owner Consultant or Subcontractor need to know Best Practices for closing out a construction project? The answer is simple - if you can't get it done then you can't reach Substantial Performance. If End Users are not able to use the facility as intended, then all involved will have to spend more time and money to help wrap it up and everybody's monies will be delayed. Getting a project to Substantial Performance and then to Total Performance are two of the most difficult milestones in the construction process to achieve.
